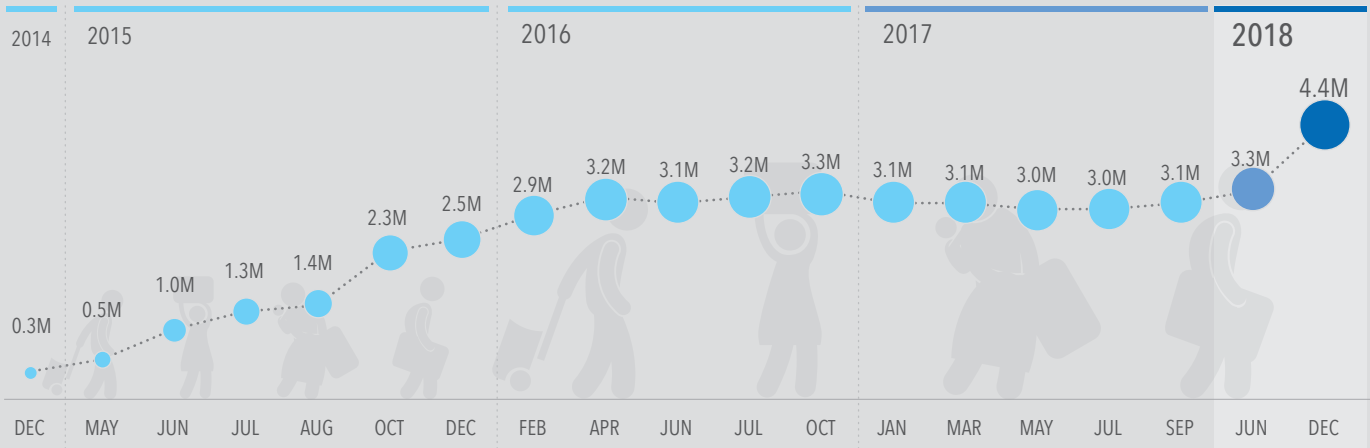
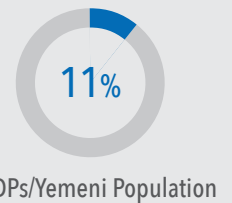
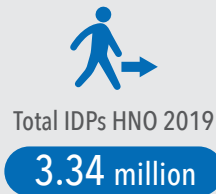


## DISPLACEMENT TRENDS (2018 - 2014)
